

2017 JUNIOR HIGH LEAGUE COMPETITION

DATES – Round 1 of the tournament will be played on Thursday, January 12, Round 2 on Thursday, January 26, Round 3 on Thursday, February 2, Round 4 on Thursday, February 9, Round 5 on Thursday, February 16, and round 6 on Thursday February 23. If more than one round is cancelled because of inclement weather or for any other reason, then the final round will be played on Thursday, March 2. Competition is scheduled to begin at 5:00 each week.

PLACE – The tournament will be played at Wydown Middle School, 6500 Wydown, Saint Louis, Missouri, 63105.

REGISTRATION – Registration is required for each round. Registration will be from 3:45 p.m. to 4:30 p.m. Players or teams registering after 4:30 will be subject to a \$5.00 late fee.

ELIGIBILITY – All students in kindergarten through grade nine are eligible. Players may not compete in sections including grades higher than the highest grade in the school the player represents.

NINTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – Students in kindergarten through grade nine are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. In all rounds each player will play two games against one opponent. The team score is the sum of the four highest player scores. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Awards will depend on the number players in each grade.

EIGHTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – Students in kindergarten through grade eight are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. In all rounds each player will play two games against one opponent. The team score is the sum of the four highest player scores. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Awards will depend on the number players in each grade.

SIXTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – Students in kindergarten through grade six are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. In all rounds each player will play two games against one opponent. The team score is the sum of the four highest player scores. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Awards will depend on the number players in each grade.

FIFTH GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – Students in kindergarten through grade five are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. In all rounds each player will play two games against one opponent. The team score is the sum of the four highest player scores. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Awards will depend on the number players in each grade.

THIRD GRADE AND UNDER DIVISION FORMAT – Students in kindergarten through grade three are eligible. Each school may enter any number of players. In all rounds each player will play two games against one opponent. The team score is the sum of the four highest player scores. The time control is game in thirty minutes. Awards will depend on the number players in each grade.

ENTRY FEE – The entry fee is \$10.00 per player.

EQUIPMENT – Players are responsible for providing sets, boards, clocks and either pen or pencil for writing game notation. Limited numbers of sets, boards and clocks will be available for those without necessary equipment. Equipment may be on sale during the tournament.

SPONSORS – Each school must have either a sponsor or parent present. There will be a sponsors and parents meeting during round one.
